LogRx and Canejo Health is proud to partner on a new pro-

to fight fentanyl overdoses. Canejo Health will be equipping first responders with buprenorphine for treating patients who overdose, alongside Narcan that helps address the critical withdrawal period that often leads to repeated use and potential overdose. Conejo Health handles the logistics for the EMS buprenorphine program throughout the county, and will be using LogRx to manage this operation

Project Goals:

Collaboratively, Canejo Health and LogRx plan to help reduce opioid deaths and assist with the homeless crisis faced in California. The project is already underway, but the goal with LogRx supporting the program will be to improve overall management of operations and provide actionable analytics to guide focus of the program in the future.

Canejo Health is focused on the distribution and administration of buprenorphine throughout

Ventura County. Handling 100% of the logistics for EMS providers. LogRx will be utilized to manage their operations and analyze the data they gather where overdoses are decreasing.

Ventura County has already seen a 37% reduction in fentanyl deaths from 2023 to 2024. LogRx's donation will play an important role in Conejo Health's mission to save lives. LogRx began working with Canejo Health in 2025, so the goal is to continue community impact with more positive results and more detailed analytics that can be utilized to guide focus in the future.

For LogRx the project serves as a way to utilize a program originally designed for tracking narcotics to be utilized in other manners to assist EMS professionals.
